

# Peru PROJECT SUMMARY 2016



#### **Present Realities**

Beach Corner Church has worked alongside ATEK ministries in reaching the Quechan people since 2008 by providing much needed training in agricultural methods, health & sanitation, marriage & parental conduct specifically in the area of Huanca Huanca. Since then there has been a transformation that has taken place within the community that has seen improvements in the overall quality of life to the point that ATEK wants to use the same model to branch out into other communities.

Pastoral / leadership training has also been an area of need and focus which is why ATEK has hosted up to 60 pastors who have provided much needed biblical training.

### Plan of Action

Women's Conference: Providing the resources for a 15 day women's conference for 40 to 50 women. Beach Corner church will take part in assisting the day to day for 1 week by providing care for 30 children, preparing meals, and sharing a daily devotional. The cost of the conference also includes hiring a translator for Pastor Bill's teaching.

Kid's Camp's: 2 new villages, the local community will provide food while the team will organize games, crafts, drama, and teaching on health practices.

Painting ATEK Building: The ATEK building still needs to be painted which the team will contribute towards and participate in if time allows.

# **Project Benefits**

Women's Conference: Equipping and training women from many different villages with a biblical foundation which will enable them to reach others in their communities.

Kid's Camp's: A great way to build relationship with a community is through hosting kids camps. This not only allows for the gospel to be shared but also opens up other opportunities to teach hygiene, leadership development, and agricultural practices to improve the communities quality of spiritual and physical life.

Painting ATEK Building: Providing a fresh coat of paint will make the building a more welcoming place to host conferences/training seminars in addition to the everyday work place of the ATEK staff.
